



## GIN IS IN!

Interest in gin has grown hugely over the last decade and independent producers are flourishing, with more emphasis on artisan methods of production. Here are a few of our favourites:

### Plymouth Original

A unique gin produced in our very own city since 1793 in the oldest functioning gin distillery in the country and, the only gin to have Protected Designation of Origin status!

### Plymouth Sloe

Made by steeping the finest sloes in Plymouth Gin and soft pure Dartmouth water. The winner of several awards; try this gin topped up with delicious sparkling Prosecco or a tangy bitter lemon.

### Tarquin's Cornish Dry

A contemporary take on a classic London dry, using fragrant, handpicked Devon violets and fresh orange zest to deliver an aromatic sensation unlike any other.

### Bombay Sapphire

Launched in 1987, its name recognises the popularity of gin in India during the British Raj. The 'sapphire' in question is the Star of Bombay and the flavouring comes from a mix of ten botanical ingredients.

### Hendrick's

Launched in 1999 and rapidly becoming the connoisseur's gin of choice. As well as using Juniper they also use Bulgarian rose and cucumber to add flavour.

### Gordon's

First produced in 1769 by Alexander Gordon, a Londoner of Scottish descent. The special London dry gin he developed was so successful that the recipe remains unchanged to this day!

### Bulldog

Infused with twelve of the rarest, most distinctive botanicals assembled in a gin, including lotus leaves, lavender and dragon eye (cousin of the lychee fruit) Bulldog London Dry Gin is quadruple-distilled in traditional copper pot stills guarding a time-honoured tradition of distilling.

### The King of Soho

Distilled in the heart of London using traditional methods, The King of Soho is a London Dry Gin crafted with twelve botanicals to a unique flavour profile. Celebrating the spirit of Soho, the beautiful bottle design embodies the characteristics that make Soho unique - an area rich in creativity, music, art and modern culture.

### Pinkster Agreeably British

Pinkster is a small-batch premium gin that launched in summer 2013. Made with hand-steeped fresh, locally grown raspberries at our Cambridge headquarters, Pinkster is deliciously dry, with a hint of raspberry and the smoothest of finishes. Pinkster is the brainchild of bean counter and ginmeister Stephen Marsh who experimented for several years at home, foisting creations upon unsuspecting friends.

### Blackwoods Vintage

Blackwoods Gin is the world's first Vintage Dry Gin. Shetland botanicals are infused with juniper and coriander, and other botanicals including lime, before being steeped in natural mineral water to release their gentle flavours to give the gin its unique and complex character. The distillation is then done in small batches using a traditional copper pot still.

## VODKA

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### **Aval Dor Cornish Vodka**

In 1904 Stafford Matthew Dustow fulfilled his lifelong ambition and bought a quaint little farm nestled in the heart of Cornwall. Over 100 years have passed and now Stafford's great, great grandsons are transforming their finest King Edward potatoes into a premium vodka spirit. Distilled in a tiny copper batch still then blended with mineral water from an aquifer deep beneath the farm, Aval Dor is a voluptuous and viscous vodka that can be enjoyed neat over cracked ice or as part of your favourite cocktail.

### **Black Cow Dorset Vodka**

Black Cow Pure Milk Vodka, a super-premium vodka, the first of its kind made entirely from the milk of grass grazed cows and nothing else. Milk makes exceptionally smooth vodka with a unique creamy character. The milk is separated into curds and whey. The curds are used to make cheese; the whey is fermented into a beer using a special yeast that converts the milk sugar into alcohol. This milk beer is then distilled and treated to our secret blending process. The vodka is then triple filtered and finished, before being hand bottled.

### **Chase Marmalade Vodka**

Beginning life as the 'World's Best' Chase Vodka, the smooth and creamy spirit is marinated with a bespoke Seville orange fine marmalade in the Chase alembic copper pot still; Ginny. The resultant spirit is then further distilled in the world's tallest rectification column (standing at 70ft) with the vapours passing through fresh Valencian and Sevillian orange peel, creating a beautifully bittersweet and 100% natural orange experience.

### **Grey Goose Vodka**

Grey Goose is made from the finest soft winter wheat from the Picardy region in France - the highest grade of wheat used in the finest French breads and pastries. It is distilled only once in a continuous-column distillation process to ensure the quality of the wheat remains to give Grey Goose its extraordinary flavour.

### **Sipsmith Sipping Vodka**

An unadulterated, unfiltered vodka for sipping. A testament to how we handcraft all our award-winning spirits. Distilled in copper for purity and only ever made with the very best spirit from the heart of the distillation run. This means there is no need to filter, add glycerine, fructose, or any aromatisers. No compromises; just pure unadulterated, smooth, Sipping Vodka.

### **Smirnoff Red**

Made using a traditional charcoal filtration method developed by P.A. Smirnoff. Recipe NO.21 was created by P.A.'s son Vladimir after escaping Russia and the Bolshevik revolution. Now reputed to be the best selling Vodka in the world!

## RUM

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### **The Kraken Black Spiced Rum**

The Kraken Black Spiced Rum is the first imported black spiced rum from the Caribbean, blended with 14 secret spices. The Kraken Rum is distilled at the Fernandes distillery in Trinidad and aged for between two to three years in ex-American whiskey barrels. Named after a sea beast of myth and legend, The Kraken is strong, rich, black and smooth. While the smooth taste of The Kraken lends itself to be enjoyed as a sipping rum, it can also be enjoyed as a key ingredient in cocktails.

### **Mount Gay Rum Eclipse**

Distilled in Barbados this rum was named after the double phenomenon of a total solar eclipse and the passing of Halley's comet in 1910.

### **Bacardi**

The first white rum in the world, founded in Cuba the traditional Bacardi bat logo was inspired by the fruit bats that lived in the rafters of the original distillery.

### **Captain Morgan's Spiced Gold**

Named after the 17th-century Welsh privateer of the Caribbean, Sir Henry Morgan who died on 26 August 1688. Since 2011, the label has used the slogan "To Life, Love and Loot".

## SINGLE MALTS

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### **Monkey Shoulder**

Some say it tastes just like riding bareback on the wild moors of Scotland with a flame haired maiden on Christmas morning. Others agree it tastes like 007 wearing a tuxedo wetsuit. If you haven't tried either yet but want a handy little cheat sheet to check out, here you go - but remember it's completely up to you, what you think it tastes like.

### **Aberlour 10 year old**

The Aberlour distillery is consistently recognised in the most prestigious international whisky competitions for producing single malts of exceptional quality and depth.

### **Glenfiddich 12 year old**

Carefully matured in the finest American bourbon and Spanish sherry oak casks for at least 12 years. Married and mellowed in oak marrying tuns for complete harmony of aroma and flavour.

### **Glenmorangie**

The original expression of our elegant, floral spirit and the real backbone of the Glenmorangie range. A ten-year-old single malt, Glenmorangie Original is produced by marrying the delicate spirit that emerges from Scotland's tallest stills, with first and second fill American white oak casks.

### **Knockando**

The pale, golden colour of Knockando is entirely natural. It is derived solely from the casks in which it has matured - casks held together without nails or glue. No colouring is ever added and only natural ingredients are used - malted barley, yeast and crystal clear spring water from the Cardnach spring, which lies in the hills above the distillery.

### **Talisker**

Talisker 10 Year Old Whisky is the cornerstone of the Talisker family, a powerful peat and sea-salt nose; smoky sweetness with malt flavours and developing warmth with a huge peppery finish. Built in 1830, Talisker is the only malt whisky distillery made on the coastline of the rugged, Isle of Skye. Its smell and taste instantly connect you with its origin - like a warm welcome from a wild sea.

### **Laphroaig 10 year old**

In making Laphroaig, malted barley is dried over a peat fire. The smoke from this peat, found only on Islay, gives Laphroaig its particularly rich flavour. Those enjoying the 10 Year Old will first notice the bold, smoky taste, followed by a hint of seaweed and a surprising sweetness. This full-bodied variant is the foundation of all Laphroaig expressions and comes with a long finish.

## BOURBON

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### **Buffalo Trace Bourbon**

Buffalo Trace Kentucky Straight Bourbon is the flagship bourbon from the most awarded distillery in the world and we are rightly proud to have this great product in our portfolio. It is generally accepted to be the most rounded of bourbons, and the ultimate blend of the four required taste sensations - smoky, sweet, spicy and smooth. Aged for at least eight years, it has been described as "one of the world's great whiskies" by Jim Murray (author of Jim Murray's Whisky Bible).

### **Bulleit Rye Bourbon**

Bulleit has always respected the opinions of bartenders and mixologists who introduce the brand to new adult consumers every day. These tastemakers helped Tom Bulleit realize the potential for a new rye and inspired its creation. Bulleit has always been known for its high rye content and the recipe for Bulleit's small batch straight rye is 95% rye and 5% malted barley. Our limestone filtered water source is from an ancient glacial aquifer - some hundreds of feet below the distillery and the reason for its location.

### **Woodford Reserve Borbon**

Woodford Reserve Bourbon is a super premium bourbon, hand made in small batches. It's the only one in the world to be triple distilled in traditional copper pots, all from the oldest and smallest operating distillery in America. A highly awarded bourbon recognised and loved by whiskey connoisseurs. Enjoy the rich taste with notes of caramel, vanilla and butterscotch and a hint of roasted nuts.

## ALLERGENS FOUND IN WINE

### Sulphur Dioxide

SO<sub>2</sub> is used to a certain extent in the making of virtually all wine and is a by-product of fermentation, therefore virtually all wine contains this level of sulphites.

### Milk and Egg

Casein is the principal milk protein, used as a fining agent. If used, it is mostly for whites to get rid of a brown colour or for clearing cloudy wine. Egg whites are used in the production of fine red wines for fining as they gently adsorb the harsh and bitter tannins.

### Fish

Isinglass, a particularly pure protein obtained from the bladders of sturgeon and other freshwater fish has been used for fining wine for centuries. It reacts with the excess tannins in harsh young red wines and is occasionally used to clarify white wines to be bottled without a final filtration.
